

Eco-Kid Award

During the month of May each year the Woodleaf staff reviews entries in the Eco-Kid Competition. Entries are judged based on the work described in student essays. The winning entry will receive a \$100 prize along with an additional \$100 prize for his/her classroom. The prizes will be awarded by the Woodleaf Director to the student at his/her school during the last week of May or first week of June.

All essays should include the following information:

1. When the student attended Woodleaf Outdoor School
2. What impact the Woodleaf experience had on the student
3. What the student has done since returning home from Woodleaf that qualifies him/her to be an Eco-Kid.

Previous Eco-Kids have organized clean-up efforts in their schools and communities, have educated other students and family members about recycling, organized efforts to build and place kestrel boxes, planned and implemented energy saving plans in their homes, and many other “eco-friendly” activities. Be creative and let us know what you’re doing in your community!
